

WORLD BID DECLARATION



- 2025 Dance Worlds

Evolution will award 2 AT LARGE Bids to the 2026 Dance Worlds at Evolution Cheer Battle 2026. Scoring is based on single performance and BIDs will be awarded to top 2 teams in dance divisions based on total points regardless divisions. Bids can only be awarded to EU member states All Star clubs/club teams. Bids can only be received in the division that the team was competing in, no division change after competition is allowed. All programs and athletes must be in good standing with the IASF.

Bids will be awarded to 2 teams with the highest "Total Scores" to a Senior Team in the following divisions for Dance Worlds:

- Open Hip Hop (OHH)
- Open Coed Hip Hop (OCHH)
- Open Male Hip Hop (OMHH)
- Open Jazz (OJ)
- Open Coed Jazz (OCJ)
- Open Pom (OP)
- Open Coed Pom (OCP)
- Open Open (Contemporary/Lyrical) (OOCL)
- Junior Jazz (U16)
- Junior Pom (U16)
- Junior Hip Hop (U16)

If necessary, bids may pass down in order of ranking by score.

Tie Breaker Policy

In the event that there is a tie for a Worlds bid, the following Tie-Breaker policy will apply:

- The bid will be awarded to the team with the least amount of deductions.
- If the deductions are equal or zero, the bid will be awarded to the team with the highest score in the Overall category.
- If the Overall category scores remain equal, the tie will be broken by the judges' choice.

Crossovers & Athlete verification

Crossovers are not permitted between two teams in the same division. No crossovers will be permitted between teams competing for World's bids in separate divisions. Crossovers to other non-Worlds teams are permitted and not limited. Athlete verification will occur for all teams competing for World's bids, photo ID must be presented at the day of the event and rooster must be filled in and send to Evolution before the event. Evolution will follow the same substitution and alternate policies as IASF for all World's bids.
